
COURTSHIP

The Circle of Biblical Love

Agapao – acting in love towards your spouse because it is the right thing to do; independent of feelings.

Phileo – love that is emotionally positive; developing a true friendship with your spouse.

Erao (eros) – sexual behavior; designed by God to be enjoyed fully, but always within the boundaries of agapao and phileo love.
