UFO's are a phenomena we must account for. According to research by Dr. Hugh Ross:

- There have been more than ten million UFO sightings.
- There have been more than one thousand cases of 'physical effects' from a UFO.
- There are more than two thousand cases of contact with alien 'astronauts.'

One in every ten Americans has seen a UFO, including presidents Andrew Jackson and Jimmy Carter and astronauts James McDivitt and Gordon Cooper.

UFO sightings have been on the rise, for example, in China.

One such sighting in September prompted an airport to shut down to prevent aircraft from crashing into the object, media reports said this week.

The airport is located in Baotou in Inner Mongolia, and three flights that were arriving had to circle around the airport to wait until the UFO disappeared, according to UK newspaper The Sun.

Two other flights were diverted away to nearby cities. This incident was the eighth report of a UFO sighting in China in the past four months.¹

Here in the United States a group of retired airmen on September 27 at the National Press Club in Washington D.C. recounted their descriptions of UFO's seen hovering over nuclear installations.²

A story out of the United Kingdom made headlines around the world the last week of September. On September 26 telegraphuk.com posted a story titled, *UN 'to appoint space ambassador to greet alien visitors.* 8

Excerpts:

Mazlan Othman, a Malaysian astrophysicist, is set to be tasked with co-ordinating humanity's response if and when extraterrestrials make contact.

Aliens who landed on earth and asked: "Take me to your leader" would be directed to Mrs Othman.

She will set out the details of her proposed new role at a Royal Society conference in Buckinghamshire next week.

The 58-year-old is expected to tell delegates that the proposal has been prompted by the recent discovery of hundreds of planets orbiting other stars, which is thought to make the discovery of extraterrestrial life more probable than ever before.

Mrs Othman is currently head of the UN's little known Office for Outer Space Affairs (UNOOSA).

In a recent talk to fellow scientists, she said: "The continued search for extraterrestrial communication, by several entities, sustains the hope that some day human kind will received signals from extraterrestrials. "When we do, we should have in place a coordinated response that takes into account all the sensitivities related to the subject. The UN is a ready-made mechanism for such coordination."

According to the UN website,

The United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs (UNOOSA) is the United Nations office responsible for promoting international cooperation in the peaceful uses of outer space. UNOOSA serves as the secretariat for the General Assembly's only committee dealing exclusively with international cooperation in the peaceful uses of outer space...

UNOOSA is also responsible for implementing the Secretary-General's responsibilities under international space law and maintaining the United Nations Register of Objects Launched into Space.

Other news outlets following-up the story say it isn't true. Discoverynews.com, on September 28, said, "the Malaysian astrophysicist, Mazlan Othman who... was about to become the U.N.'s spokesperson for Earth, has no clue about her unprecedented promotion. "It sounds really cool but I have to deny it," Othman told *The Guardian*..."

Why does any of this interest us as students of Bible prophecy?

For one thing, there are those in the New Age community who speak about the removal from our planet of millions of individuals as 'aliens' make real contact with us. It sounds a great deal like the rapture of the church.

The Bible specifically warns us that, in the last days, demonic deceptions will increase. Could all the increase in interest and activities attributed to UFO's really be demonic?

Almost everything attributed to UFO's can be explained by demonic activity preparing the world for some great end-times deception.

Author Lynn Catoe writes,

A large part of the available UFO literature is closely linked with mysticism and the metaphysical. It deals with subjects like mental telepathy, automatic writing and invisible entities as well as phenomena like poltergeist [ghost] manifestation and 'possession.' Many of the UFO reports now being published in the popular press recount alleged incidents that are strikingly similar to demonic possession and psychic phenomena.

I like this quote from John Ankerberg and John Weldon:

... in light of the messages given by the UFO entities, how credible is it to think that literally thousands of genuine extraterrestrials would fly millions or billions of light years simply to teach New Age philosophy, deny Christianity, and support the occult? Why would they do this with the preponderance of such activity already occurring on this planet? And why would the entities actually possess and inhabit people... **just like demons do** if they were really advanced extraterrestrials?
