Every Sunday we present a prophecy update. We show how news and trends in the world corroborate centuries-old prophecies you read in the Bible.

A literal reading of the Bible reveals that in the last days the nation of Israel will be regathered to the land unconditionally promised her by God. **We are the generation privileged to see that prophecy miraculously fulfilled!**

Once regathered, the Bible predicts that Israel would become a constant burden in the affairs of all other nations and peoples of the world.

Notice, too, the dire prophesy at the end of that verse, that “all nations of the earth are gathered against” Israel.

Each year January 27 is the International Day of Commemoration in Memory of the Victims of the Holocaust. It marks the day Soviet soldiers liberated the Auschwitz death camp in 1945.

Israeli prime minister Benjamin Netanyahu made some strong statements on the 27th about the current threats to Israel’s existence.¹ Here are some of them:

“70 years after the Holocaust, much of the world remains silent in the face of Iran’s declared intent to wipe Israel off the earth.”

“Much of the world are silent in the face of calls by Hizbullah for the destruction of Israel, and its continued murderous activities. Many remain silent in the face of calls by Hamas to kill Jews wherever they are.”

"These are days when most of the governments of the world remain silent in the face of cries of Palestinian Muftis to kill Jews wherever they are. Where is the condemnation of the Mufti? Not the Mufti of history, but the Mufti of today?"

"International Holocaust Remembrance Day should be the day the world stands behind the words 'never again.' "

Rabbi Abraham Cooper wrote an op-ed piece for the Huffington Post titled, *Their Denial & Our Silence Mock International Holocaust Memorial Day*.² After listing a number of anti-Semitic activities in many of the world's developed nations, including our own, he concluded, "this International Holocaust Memorial Day we urge those who take the time to stand in silence for 6 million dead Jews, to also speak up in defense of embattled live Jews."

Reading the Bible, you'd expect to see Israel regathered in her land in the end times. You'd further expect her to be a source of controversy for all the nations of the world. And that is exactly what is happening in our world right now.
