This week I want to highlight an electronics firm called MC10. Their slogan is, "reshaping electronics." Their mission statement reads like this:

It's our mission to extend human capabilities by making high-performance electronics virtually invisible, conformal, and wearable. We reshape rigid, conventional electronics into thin, flexible devices that can stretch, bend and twist seamlessly with our bodies and the natural world. And we're making them affordable for the everyday consumer.

In 2008, founder Professor John Rogers of the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign came up with stretchable circuits. They are circuits that can bend, flex and stretch with the human body.

It's like having something the size of a postage stamp on your skin, but it's an electronic device that can do what you program it to do.

Their stated goal: To redefine the interface between electronics and the human body.

MC10 has a number of consumer and military products.

In an article highlighting wearable technology, WIRED Magazine wrote, "MC10 is a Wonka factory of crazy electronics concepts, from their tiny skinborne "Biostamps" to balloon catheters that can communicate back to doctors when they're positioned correctly inside a clogged blood vessel. On an office tour, MC10 CEO David Icke shows off a stretchable circuit that, in their in-house testing, can withstand literally millions of expansions and contractions without failing."

The WIRED article concludes by saying, "These are the sorts of fields that haven't gotten too much attention during the past 20 years of software mania, but they may get quite a bit more as the market for wearable technology ramps up."

Then they reported,

In 2011, he and his colleagues announced the invention of a device that had hitherto seemed impossible: an integrated silicon circuit with the mechanical properties of skin. The circuit stretches and wrinkles when spread and pinched. It is waterproof and harvests power from radio waves, which are emitted by cell phones.
