"Who's Afraid of Bibi?"

Regarding the upcoming appearance before Congress, the JewishPress wrote,

Former U.S. Defense Secretary Leon Panetta told CNN's "State of the Union" program on Sunday that he is "afraid" of the impact Israel's Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu will have in Congress next month.

Panetta told CNN, "I'm afraid what is going to happen here with what Netanyahu will do, is to make this partisan divide between Democrats and Republicans and that makes it a very dangerous trap."

Netanyahu was invited by House Speaker John Boehner months ago to address a joint session of Congress on the impact of Iran's galloping nuclear technology program – both globally and existentially for Israel.

The prime minister has been clear from the outset that the agreement currently being discussed between Iran and world powers led by the Obama administration is one that would enable Iran to complete the process for building an atomic weapon of mass destruction.

Iran has repeatedly vowed to annihilate Israel once it has achieved that goal; thus any agreement enabling Tehran to succeed in that direction is certainly one to be considered an existential threat to the Jewish State.

The JerusalemPost quoted Israeli Defense Minister Moshe Ya'alon saying, Iran, whose regime has “apocalyptic messianic ambition,” would become a nuclear threshold state under the terms of an agreement now under negotiation between Tehran and the six world powers.

The article went on,

The six world powers, the US, China, Russia, France, the United Kingdom and Germany, erred by allowing the negotiations to focus on how many centrifuges Iran could retain rather than insisting that the centrifuges must be removed.

Crippling sanctions forced Iran to the negotiating table, but now, “this pressure is gone,” Ya'alon said.

Renewed crippling sanctions, Ya'alon said, would force Iran to choose between halting its nuclear program or survival.

None of this surprises us. It is the kind of news, the type of trends, you'd expect from reading the prophecies of the end times.
