"Cyborg"

Each week we present what we call a Prophecy Update. This is #439 in that series.

The Bible accurately foretells specific events - in precise detail - sometimes even centuries before they occur.

Approximately 2500 prophecies appear in the pages of the Bible. About 2000, or 80%, have already been fulfilled to the letter, with no errors.

Two thousand years ago, the apostle John saw a future in which every citizen would have what he called a "mark" on their hand or forehead by which they would be identified, and by which they would transact all of their daily business.

We have reported on many technologies that sound eerily like they could become the fulfillment of that prophecy.

One we haven't reported on, which may be the creepiest of all, is humans becoming cyborgs.

Don't immediately flash to *The Terminator*, or some other ScFi representation. Cyborg is short for *cybernetic organism*. It applies to a person with any type of mechanical enhancement.

If you have a pacemaker, you are considered a cyborg.

The future for cyborgs is a lot more than pacemakers. Among the advances being made, scientists are finding ways to connect your brain to a computer.

A June 2015 article was titled, Neural lace has been invented to organically connect your brain with a computer.

Excerpts:

Scientists from China and the US have found a pioneering way to inject a tiny electronic mesh sensor into the brain that fully integrates with cerebral matter and enables computers to monitor brain activity.

Researchers from Harvard and the National Center for Nanoscience and Technology in Beijing have succeeded in inventing a flexible electrical circuit that fits inside a 0.1mm-diameter glass syringe in a water-based solution.

When injected into the brains of mice, the mesh unfurled to 30 times its size and mouse brain cells grew around the mesh, forming connections with the wires in the flexible mesh circuit.

The biochemical mouse brain completely accepted the mechanical component and integrated with it without any damage being caused to the mouse.

The authors said this about the advances being made:

[It marks] the beginning of the true human cyborgs... humans that have electronic parts in them... as well as the concept of humans having brains that can instantly tap into infinite knowledge, such as the plot in the Scarlett Johansson film *Lucy*.

A January 2016 article was titled, *US military aims to create cyborgs by connecting humans to computers.*

Excerpts:

US military's Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (Darpa) has unveiled a research program called Neural Engineering System Design (NESD) which aims to develop an implantable neural interface, connecting humans directly to computers.

At the moment, human-computer interfaces connect a large number of neurons at a time - somewhere between 100 and 1,000 - to a machine. Darpa aims to refine the technology so as to connect individual neurons. This would give much finer control, reduce noise and, in theory, speed up communications between a human and a computer.
