Australian advertising executive Ben Slater is one of a handful of people now walking around with a microchip implanted in his body. A grain of rice-sized RFID microchip has been implanted into subcutaneous tissue between the webbing of Slater's thumb and index finger in anticipation of the iPhone 6 release.

Biohacking and microchip implant technology has been around for at least a decade, though until recently, the application and usage has been limited. Recent developments of near-field communication (NFC chips) in our mobile devices is opening up a new frontier of interconnectivity and body customization which allows devices to 'talk' to each other simply by touching or being in proximity to another chip-enabled device.
